DEAR MARIST FAMILY,

I have walked the Marist halls for just about half of my life. I remember starting here as a nervous freshman. My family had moved here from Ohio, so we did not know many people. But as I walked the halls, I found friendly faces. I found Brothers who tempered being strict with their love of teaching and of God. I found teachers who were passionate and pushed us to do better. I found teammates and coaches that gave every last bit of energy they had. I found friends for life who have been with me for decades now.



When I became principal in 1998, I had a new perspective as I made my way through the halls. Marist's mission continues to drive our work. We have consistently been the leader in Catholic education and that remains true even in the face of challenges—even a global pandemic. As we move ahead in these uncharted waters, I am encouraged by the dedication of our faculty and staff who kept education moving forward for our students. This past spring, e-learning training that normally takes weeks was completed in days for the benefit of our students. At the start of this school year, two weeks were set aside for additional training focused on robust teaching methods and an improved e-learning environment. This work was led by Dr. Katie Baal, our new principal, in whom I have the utmost faith and confidence. I am excited to partner with her as we and our great team lead Marist.

We will continue to move our story forward through our faith, family spirit, and commitment to future-readiness.

I invite you join us on the journey and to walk the halls with us literally and figuratively.

New Marist leadership sets historic firsts

Larry Tucker '79 becomes first lay president and Dr. Kathryn Baal becomes first female principal at Marist

The 2020-2021 school year officially began July 1, and this year, it brought with it many changes within our administrative team. As announced during the past school year, Marist has a new president and principal at the helm.

Larry Tucker '79, who served as principal for 22 years, is now the school's first lay president. In his role, he acts as the chief executive officer and "chief executive in faith." He is responsible for driving long-range planning and all aspects of the school's general operations, financial management, and institutional advancement of the 55-acre campus.

Dr. Kathryn Baal assumed the principal's role. A seasoned educator, Dr. Baal joined Marist during the 2019-2020 school year as the director of curriculum and instruction. She now works as the chief operating officer with primary responsibility for all matters related to academic programs, student services, faculty, and the daily operations of the school. She is the first woman to serve as principal at Marist.

The number of remaining positions on the administrative team stayed the same while the roles and responsibilities changed for the new school year.

Sarah Kolkmeier, who has taught in the Religious Studies Department, managed Marist's transition to a 1:1 iPad program, and directed the Marcellin Program and Peer Leadership Program, joined the team as assistant principal of academics, overseeing course offerings, teacher development, school accreditation, and several other academic areas. **Beth O'Neill**, who served as the dean of discipline for upperclassmen, assumed the role of



assistant principal of student services. She oversees counseling, student activities, the academic resource center, and the health office, along with other student life needs.

Joe Inzinga '77, who served as the academic dean for underclassmen, and **Don Pirkle '77**, who served as the dean of discipline for underclassmen, now serve as deans of students with a new focus within their roles. Mr. Inzinga oversees juniors and seniors, while Mr. Pirkle works with freshmen and sophomores. They run class-specific programming, plan student and parent events, manage discipline issues, and oversee school safety measures and other logistical responsibilities.

These four administrators along with Athletic Director **Eric Simpson** will comprise the principal's leadership team. These changes, in part, come as a response to the growing needs and additional attention required for our students and their learning, the desire to have more structure around organizational flow and communication, and the capacity to enhance Marist's current practices to better serve all constituents, including faculty and staff.

Former President **Br. Hank Hammer, FMS**, remains at Marist Chicago, overseeing all standardized testing and semester exams, among other responsibilities. We are grateful for his six years of leadership and spiritual guidance that have made a lasting impact on our community and campus. Tom Gouterman, who worked as the academic dean for upperclassmen, wanted to return to the classroom, and now teaches in the Science Department. 📌

THE WORLD LANGUAGE DEPARTMENT offers Spanish, French, and Italian at the Marcellin, academic, honors, and Advanced Placement level and is committed to fostering authentic learning experiences. The four-year learning plan produces service-minded, informed, skillful, and effective communicators. Coursework not only emphasizes vocabulary and language, but immerses students in the native culture, too, with students visiting museums and culturally significant locations, attending special events, and connecting with local and international contacts through Zoom calls and other platforms. Students earn a variety of honors annually on the National French Contest, National Spanish Exam, and National Italian Exam. Marist sponsors an honor society for French and Spanish and social clubs for all three languages. The department also offers travel exchanges with Marist schools in France, Italy, and Argentina.

Marist band to march in Ireland

MARIST'S FAMED BAND will march in the 2021 Dublin St. Patrick's Day parade, the largest St. Patrick's Day event in the world.

The group will tour, perform, and sightsee March 12 to 20, bringing their South Side talent to the Emerald Isle. This is the first time the group will participate in an overseas trip with about 110 members and 10 chaperones set to participate. The band has previously traveled to New York, New Orleans, Canada, Disney World, and other locations, along with marching in the Rose Bowl Parade and playing on the *Tonight Show with Jay Leno* and at Comerica Park (now Guaranteed Rate Stadium).

"This is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for us," band director **Andrew Creagh '04** said. "The students are really excited to be part of such a unique trip."

The band will practice for the big event in an upgraded Shannon Music Center at Marist. Improvements were made during Summer 2020 that will be featured in an upcoming issue of *The Point*. 



What could have been ...

Several events were canceled last spring due to COVID-19.

- » The math team once again qualified for the state final at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, but the contest was not held.
- » Senior artists were unable to showcase their portfolios at the annual spring show.
- » The theatre guild was just weeks from presenting *Brigadoon* to audiences for their spring musical.

- » The renowned band had its spring tour through New Orleans and its spring concerts canceled.

African American history. A group of students attended the Archdiocesan African American Heritage Prayer Service that was held at St. Rita High School this year. The month culminated with a student-run fashion show that featured Marist models and Black Chicagoland designers.



▲ Marist held its **eighth annual Relay for Life** on **March 7** with more than 300 students participating and more than \$46,000 being raised. The all-night event was planned by a student committee and benefits the American Cancer Society. The evening included touching tributes, keynote speakers, and also featured fun games, activities, and entertainment. **Emily Patula ’20**, whose grandmother died from breast cancer, encourages teens to participate. “It is important for young people to get involved in events like these because it gives them the chance to make a difference,” she said.

State Success

Cheer program brings home another state trophy

MARIST'S VARSITY CHEER-LEADING TEAM finished third at the IHSA large division finals held February 7 and 8 in Bloomington, Ill. Marist was the only Catholic school in the top 25 teams in the large division, and this year's trophy was the third earned by the program in as many seasons.

The team gave a clean routine on Friday evening, qualifying for Saturday's finals. They were in fifth place at that point, though the scores do not carry over to the finals.

Saturday, the RedHawks were exceptional, hitting their elements and giving an excellent routine. The team was thrilled as Marist was announced as the third place team in the state.

"It's nerve-wracking waiting for the results, but it feels so good to be with your teammates," said **Laila Dorsey '22**. "It felt absolutely amazing to hear us called. We were so happy to make the podium especially because of how close we are as a team this year."

Indeed, all the team members and coaches were thrilled with the outcome after a season filled with hard work. **Caitlin Richter '20** has gone downstate four times with the program and said this year was special. "We started from scratch this year to build our team, and it felt even better than before that we made it [to the podium]," she said.

Marist's program now has the second highest number of state trophies in the school's history.

In 2013, 2018, and 2019 the team took home the state runner-up trophy. They also earned a third place finish in 2014. Marist has qualified for the state tournament 14 of the 15 years that cheer has been an IHSA sport. The program also won a state title in the Illinois Cheerleading Coaches Association (ICCA) before it was an IHSA sport. Additionally, the junior varsity squad placed first in the ICCA state finals this season, so the future of the program is bright.

"I'm honored to have the opportunity — especially at a Catholic school — to have this kind of program," Dorsey added. "We are proud of what we have accomplished together."

Richter said cheerleading is now a "new legacy" at Marist and is excited to see the fundamentals of the program being

passed down. The program's success, she said, is helping people see how strong the program is. "Most people see us on the sidelines and think that is what we do," she said. "But we work ten months a year on our skills and it's important." Their accomplishments, she said, are getting the attention of others and they are seeing the team's hard work and talent. 📌

Marist rises to the challenge in the midst of pandemic

On Friday, March 13, Marist faculty, staff, and students left school for spring break. It was anticipated that we might be home for a couple of weeks, so teachers were given Zoom logins and used their week off to prep for remote learning. The reality was that for the remainder of the school year the building never reopened.

In the face of the pandemic, when so much was unknown, some things rang true: We were still learning. We were still praying. We were still Marist. Teachers and students quickly adjusted to e-learning, meeting on Zoom, finding apps and resources to complete work, and continuing to create art, music, and more. As a community, Marist rallied together to provide spiritual resources and health and wellness information. Then principal Larry Tucker '79 offered a daily video message to inspire and challenge students and seniors offered The Memorare each afternoon online. The challenges presented revealed a resilient community.

Beyond students, Marist parents and alumni came together. The school featured Marist family-owned restaurants and alumni working on the front lines of the pandemic and held six Facebook Live concerts showcasing alumni musicians. The Marist community stepped up to make a virtual Champagnat Day on April 22 a huge success.

As the 2020 school year started, Marist implemented a hybrid schedule that combined in-person and remote learning. It broke the student body into two groups so that only half the population was in the building at any given time. Class sizes were limited and rooms were set up to promote social distancing. Masks were required and increased sanitation practices were implemented. Efforts were also made to continue to build a sense of community and school spirit through distanced activities, increased student support services, and the addition of Hawk Hall, a weekly in-person class for students to interact and engage in different aspects of Marist life. 📌

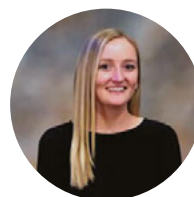

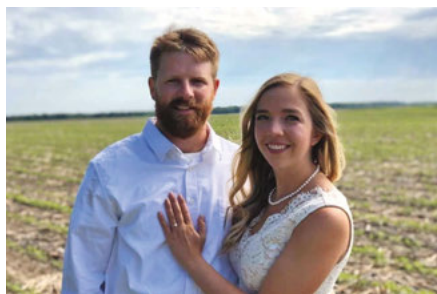

Marist Completes Largest Fundraising Effort to Date

The Faith in the Future Campaign, the largest fundraising effort in Marist history, reached full funding for the \$15 million project as of June 2020. The campaign transformed the Brothers' Monastery into the Gregory and Mary Beeson Science Center at Monastery Hall and Our Lady Queen of the Heavens Planetarium.

The 28,000-square-foot space provides 10 spacious labs dedicated to the branches of science, including an enclosed forensics crime lab for

processing evidence and a diagnostics area with medical simulators that present life-like health symptoms. The 30-seat planetarium allowed for the introduction of astronomy and can also be used for innovative presentations in other academic areas.

All students have their science courses in the wing and it has been transformative for group work, quick transitions from lecture to lab work, and integration of meaningful technology. 📌

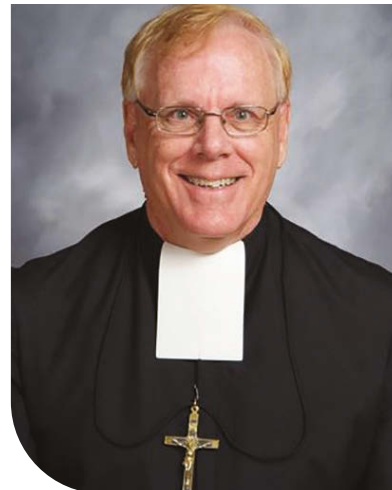
