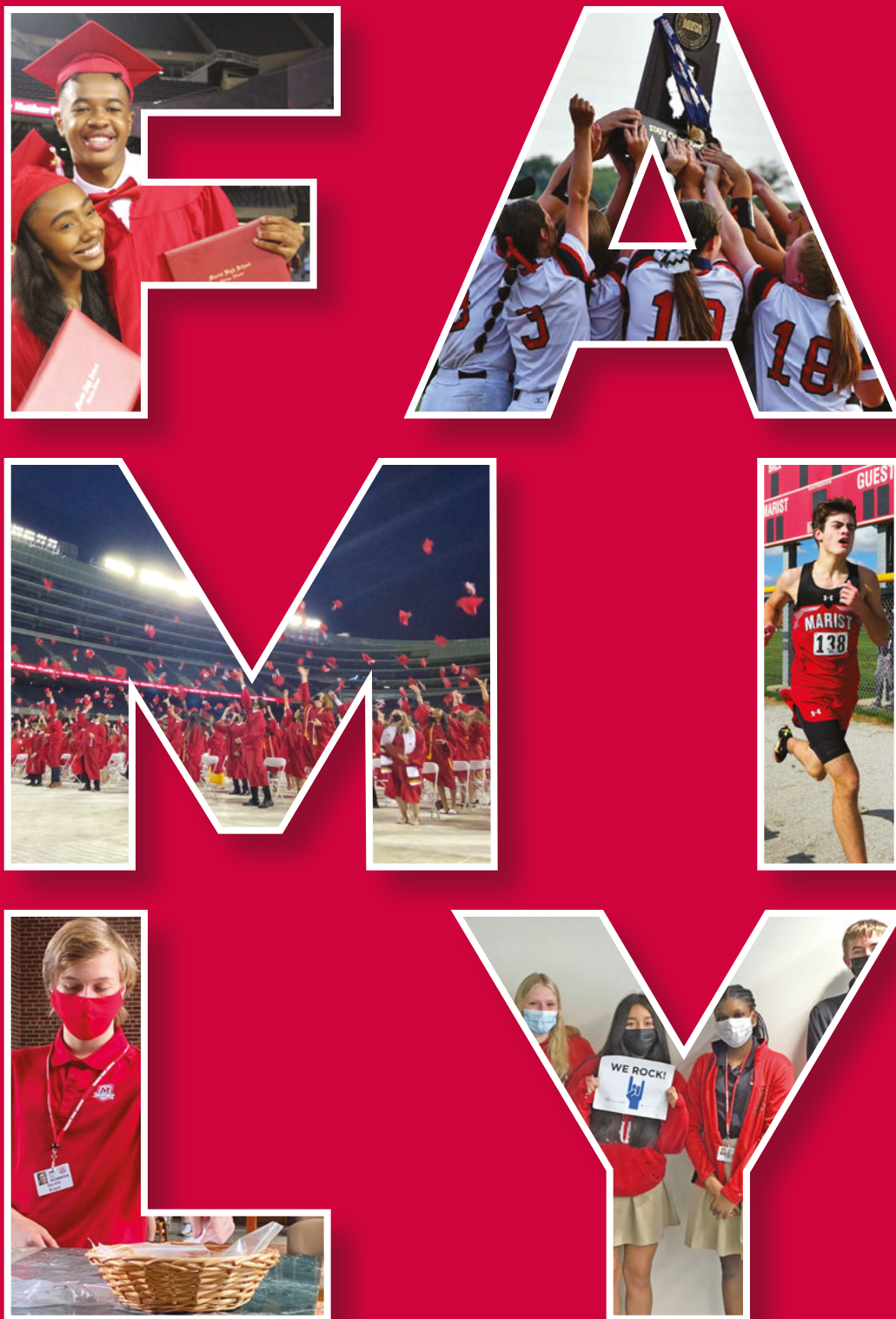

### DEAR MARIST FAMILY,

As the holiday season is here, it never ceases to amaze me how quickly the first few months of the school year pass. The reality is for more than a year we have been adjusting to life in a pandemic. This year because we are *all* together again learning in our classrooms, walking the hallways, eating in the cafeteria, and rooting for our teams from the sidelines the time has gone by even faster.

When we step back, we realize this experience has changed us all. We have gained a *deeper appreciation for time spent with each other and developed a greater trust in one another.*

During this holiday season devoted to these very things – gratitude, togetherness, and faith – we are reminded to make time for reflection. I welcome this opportunity now more than ever.

In thinking about the 2020–2021 school year, first and foremost, I acknowledge our administrative leadership, faculty, and staff for the concern and effort put forth to address the unprecedented times through which we are living:

- During the summer of 2020, the Marist team spent countless hours creating a hybrid schedule for the new school year to allow for synchronous and asynchronous learning to ensure students could safely re-enter the school building.
- Many health protocols, logistical changes, and extra student support services were added in response to the pandemic.
- Coaches and moderators remained staunchly dedicated to their athletic teams and clubs to ensure our students were given opportunities to showcase their talents and excel in their co-curricular activities.

Additionally, I also value the resolve our students displayed to make great achievements in academics, athletics, and devotion:

- In 2021, 312 students took 683 Advanced Placement (AP) exams. Last year, 48 students earned AP Scholar Awards for their performance on multiple exams, including 17 scholars with honor, and nine scholars with distinction.
- The class of 2021 earned more than \$51.5 million in scholarships.
- Our athletic teams and clubs were honored with a range of distinctions, up to and including a state championship, player of the year awards, national merit scholarship awards, a journalism state champion, and many others.

Our willingness to adapt has helped us thrive at a time when many are struggling. This speaks volumes of how we, as a family, are inspired to walk in the footsteps of Saint Marcellin Champagnat, knowing the next steps of our journey will be revealed when the time was right. I am profoundly grateful for the trust we have in one another.

On the pages ahead, you will read about the many successes we achieved together throughout the last year. I offer my sincerest gratitude to the Marist family for all that we have accomplished. I also recognize our many donors, who we highlight in the Donor Recognition Report shared within this edition. Your support makes every one of the special moments that took place this past year possible. Thank you for an incredible 2020–2021 school year, and I look forward to all we will achieve this year in the spirit of our incredible family. ## MEET MEG DUNNEBACK: Q&A with Marist's New Principal



**MEG DUNNEBACK WAS NAMED** the new principal of Marist High School in April 2021. Mrs. Dunneback, originally from New York, first established her roots in Chicago while teaching English at Marist from 1995 to 2001, where she was instrumental in the development of the Marcellin Program. Meg went on to become a teacher, facilitator, and dean at Richards High School in Oak Lawn. Since 2014, she has served as the assistant principal for curriculum and instruction. During her time at Richards, Dunneback worked on professional development with teachers to enhance today's best practices, impacting diverse learners. She brings more than 20 years of experience and is an accomplished educator with deep ties to the Marist family and local community. Meg Dunneback assumed her new role July 1, 2021. We are excited to welcome Meg back home and share the following Q & A with her.

### **Q: What made you want to take on the role as Principal at Marist High School?**

**A:** I first want to say, I loved working at Richards. I was there for 20 years. The decision to leave there was not one I came to easily. The role of Principal at Marist spoke to me as a way to grow myself and my career. I have worked in many aspects of education: teacher, facilitator, dean, assistant principal. If I am being honest, I never saw myself leaving the classroom. Each step along the way taught me so much. The role of facilitator was a challenge because for the first time I was a leader of some of the teachers I previously was teaching beside. I was now seen in a new way by my colleagues. We were able to really do some meaningful work with the students in our at-risk population. The role of the dean is one where I really was challenged with a new type of patience. I was digging into the behaviors of our students and getting them to work on changes within themselves for the better in their own life, not just in high school, but beyond. As Assistant Principal, I worked with the district as a whole to champion our teaching staff but also to guide them in their own work with students keeping up with best practices in education. Not one of these jobs has been better than the other, but the best job in my eyes is still the classroom teacher. This new role of principal will be a huge welcome challenge for me. I know I will not always get it right, but I also know I will give it my whole heart and work as hard as I can for our students and staff.

### **Q: What will you work to accomplish in your first year in your new role?**

**A:** As I start at Marist, my goal is to build relationships with the students and staff and then anyone connected to Marist. I believe relationships are the foundation of our work in education. Marist is a successful school. My job is to help lead Marist into the future of education and continue its success.

### **Q: What do you feel is most critical to ensuring the success of our students and school?**

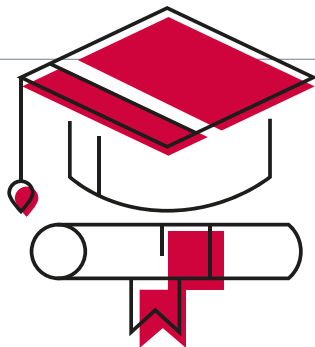
**A:** As a parent and an educator, I believe supporting one another is a crucial element in a school's community. I am concerned with our youth, especially after this past year and a half and dealing with the pandemic. As much as many students were able to put their best foot forward, I feel many of them struggled and still might be struggling in the areas of academics and the social and emotional aspects of their lives. We all need connection more than ever and this should be a focus as we move into this school year. Providing instruction that sets our students up for success beyond their time at Marist is also critical, so working with our teachers to make sure they have the support and resources they need is a priority. Beyond that, Marist is about the student experience during their four years and beyond. Connecting our current students with our alumni is imperative to the school's continued success.

### **Q: What do you like to do when you are not at school?**

**A:** Outside of work I like to spend time with my family. I moved here from New York, and I go back there as often as I can. I am one of four children, but I am the only one who is a plane ride away from immediate and extended family. There is nothing like the feeling I get when I take my husband and kids "home" to my family. It's a great way to recharge my battery. I also love the neighborhood where we live and try to contribute as best as we can with neighborhood projects. My Chicago family runs the Papa Hops Softball Tournament. My husband is very involved and contributes to its success, which provides support to local youth athletics and assists neighborhood families by cancer.

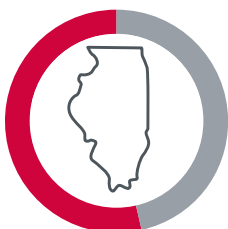

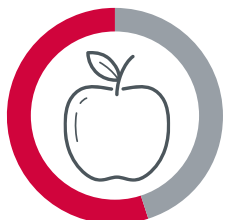

# Academic Accomplishments

As you know, Marist High School offers test preparation classes on campus for all standardized tests, along with a strong curriculum that readies students for exam content. The top quartile of Marist's Class of 2021 average ACT score is 28.58. Marist has had nine students earn a 36 on the ACT since 2004; seven of them since 2016.

Last year, **Kelly Hughes**, a current senior at Marist, scored a perfect 36 on the ACT. She also is currently a semi-finalist for the 2022 National Merit Scholarship Program.

Also, congratulations goes to seniors, **Mark J. Viz** and **Brae U. Sanchez** on being named Commended Students in the 2022 National Merit Scholarship Program. Commended Students place among the top 50,000 students who enter the competition. Approximately, 1.5 million high school students enter the program each year.

# Marist's math team finishes seventh in state

**MARIST'S MATH TEAM** competed in the ICTM Math Regional/State Competition from March 16 to March 18. The entire Marist math team was recognized as finishing seventh overall in state, continuing an incredible run of yearly top 10 finishes in the state of Illinois.

At the regional level, the team captured first place finishes in Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2, Pre-Calculus, Freshman/Sophomore 8-Person, Junior-Senior 8-Person, and Calculator. This was a sweep of all of the levels of competition. Individual achievements were earned by **Michael Alfano '24** (1<sup>st</sup>), **Andy Viz '24** (2<sup>nd</sup>), **Moir McKee '23** (1<sup>st</sup>), **Sean Grobarcik '23** (1<sup>st</sup>), **Quinn Richards '23** (3<sup>rd</sup>), **Walter Fleming '23** (4<sup>th</sup>), **Brae Sanchez '22** (1<sup>st</sup>), **Brian Winstead '22** (4<sup>th</sup>), **Caitlin McGrath '21** (1<sup>st</sup>), **Tommy Kavanaugh '21** (1<sup>st</sup>), and **Jack Vulich '21** (3<sup>rd</sup>).

At the state level, the Geometry team of McKee, Grobarcik, Richards, and Fleming finished in sixth. The freshman-sophomore eight-person also earned a 10<sup>th</sup> place finish at the state level.

Earlier in the year, the senior squad had an impressive showing at the prestigious Loyola Math Teachers' Association contest. The team is coached by long-time Marist math instructors Mr. Owen Glennon and **Mr. Jeff Nicholson '81**. 


# Sentinel awards from March

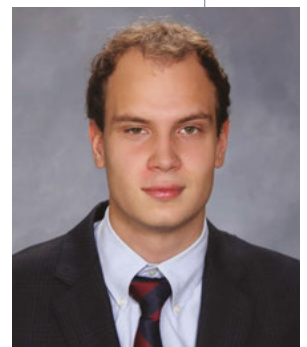
**DURING THE 2020-2021** school year, the *Sentinel* earned national, state and local awards for excellence, including First Place with Special Merit from the American Scholastic Press Association. This was the ninth consecutive year that the *Sentinel* won a first place rating in the APSA contest.

A number of RedHawk journalists also won awards at the local and state level for articles they wrote throughout the 2020-2021 school year.

The *Sentinel* has also earned a first-class rating with three marks of distinction from the National Scholastic Press Association and a superior and excellent achievement awards from the Scholastic Press Association of Chicago for overall newspaper and overall layout.

In the 2021 IHSA state journalism competition series, 7 RedHawk journalists advanced to state, including double sectional champion **PJ Cunningham** (headline writing and caption writing), **Grace Molenhouse** (champion-advertising, third place-editorial cartooning), **Julia Reedy** (second place-editorial writing), **Matthew Warakowski** (second place-review writing), **Emma Fishback** (second place-copy writing), **Billy McNicholas** (third place-sports writing) and **Delaney Powers** (third place-copy editing).

**PJ Cunningham** became the first RedHawk journalist to win state (caption writing) and the second RedHawk to take a second state medal (third place-headline writing). **Matthew Warakowski** placed fourth in state in review writing.

## E.P.I.C wins seventh annual pitch night

**M**arist High School held its seventh annual pitch night on Wednesday, May 5, which featured students enrolled in Innovative Design for Entrepreneurial Applications (IDEA).

A preliminary round of presentations was held a week prior in which eight teams participated and five advanced to the finals. Students pitched their companies to the audience, including the IDEA executive board, a group made up of successful business leaders from a variety of industries. Potential companies included items for inter-

changeable athletic cleats, an EpiPen carrier, a travel cup holder liner, a job app, and an electrolyte mint.

After all the teams presented, the IDEA executive board deliberated backstage. It was a difficult decision, but in the end, three teams received some level of funding. The first-place team, E.P.I.C., designed a phone case that would hold an EpiPen for easy carrying and traveling for those with severe allergies and received \$10,000 in funding. In second place with a \$5,000 funding award, the Out of Ideas team with their web app OnJob, which connects those in need of workers with job seekers through a simple interface. In third place,

with a \$2,500 funding award, was team E-Z with their E-Z Cup, which is a silicone liner for car cup holders keeping them neat and clean. All three teams will have to meet benchmarks in continuing to develop their company in order to receive full funding.

Each team worked with an adult mentor throughout the year who brought his or her professional know-how to the group.


“I am proud of all the students. They did an amazing job of growing individually as well as teammates,” course instructor Jim Henneberry said. “They’ve developed lifelong skills including problem solving, cognitive thinking and team collaboration.”

Prize money came from donations to the Marist business curriculum initiative, which also includes finance students investing real money in the stock market, a stock market ticker in the cafeteria, and a move toward hands-on business learning in innovative space at the school. “We want our students to have real world learning experiences, so they have every advantage entering college and the work world,” President Larry Tucker ’79 explained. “For us that means providing strong curriculum, dynamic space, and current technology. These kids are the leaders for the 21<sup>st</sup> century, and we want to make sure they have the necessary tools.”

Senior and junior students enrolled in this course created and fully developed their own product or service. Student teams worked

through the process of ideation, market research, and business plan development. They learned about marketing, accounting, and human resources, as well as the legal aspects of running a business. This is a hands-on course created to allow students to imagine, design, construct, market, and refine their own business ventures.

## Former Teacher Will Lead Efforts to Focus on Diversity, Equity and Inclusion

**FORMER SPANISH TEACHER** LaToya Hayes has left the classroom to become the Director of Diversity, Equity and Inclusion, a new leadership role created by the administrative team this school year.

"[This is a new position that] I don't take lightly, and it is a role that has many layers," Hayes said. "The meaning of diversity means differences. We want to take a closer look at differences, including race, ethnicity, socioeconomic status, sexual orientation, gender, disabilities, and the list goes on. We have students with various backgrounds in the building and we want to make sure that they are supported and valued. We hope to promote and celebrate our cultural diversity. We are also planning professional development opportunities aimed at promoting heightened cultural awareness for the faculty and the staff."

Though she is no longer in the classroom, Hayes believes that there are lessons she can teach in her new position.

"It does not feel like I left teaching," Hayes said. "This role offers me many opportunities to enlighten others. I still can work with faculty, staff and students. That is probably what motivated me even more to apply for the position. I did not have to leave Marist, and I did not have to leave teaching. I am still doing things I love to do in the building with the [people] I truly enjoy working with."

Hayes has planned a series of workshops for the faculty called "We are One." The first workshop, held during different periods between Sept. 21-24, focused on the topics of building classroom community and building relationships. Teachers were invited to read two articles prior to the workshops and then participate in a discussion.

"The first session was about building relationships and fostering a sense of community in the classroom," math teacher Tracy Carlson said. "I left the session with a renewed sense of hope that we can recover from the pandemic and the differences that seem to be tearing people apart. Ms. Hayes's position and programs are coming at a time when we need to acknowledge and talk about what makes us different and what can bring us back together. I know she will create safe spaces for students and faculty to have healthy conversations that will make Marist better than ever."

Hayes looks forward to working with the community this year.

"As difficult topics arise, I will be here as a resource to help teachers and students find their way," Hayes said. "I really want to make sure that the teachers have everything they need to meet the needs of every student. I also want all students to feel that their teachers genuinely care about meeting their needs so that they are able to thrive and succeed."

## ATHLETICS RECAPS

**BASEBALL** won the prestigious Do it Stevie's Way Tournament beating Brother Rice in the championship. The RedHawks finished in first place in conference with a 15-1 record. It was the first conference championship since 2007, and the first time all levels won conference titles. All-conference players included: **Cal Sefcik '23**, **Jack Harmon '21**, **Mark Brannigan '21** (Defensive Player of the Year), **Jimmy Rolder '22**, **Jack Carney '21**, and **Luke Sefcik '21** (Conference Player of the Year and *Southtown* Player of the Year). The team finished 32-5 for the season.

**HOCKEY** played a full Chicago Catholic Hockey League (CCHL) season and a shortened Hayes Division season. The team went 12-21-2 and was a Hayes Division finalist. **Liam Dougherty '22** and **Luke Schuler '21** were nominated for the CCHL all-star team. Dougherty tied for 11<sup>th</sup> place in overall league scorer with 24 points.

**BOYS' LACROSSE** celebrated its 10<sup>th</sup> year with an overall record of 10-5. All-conference players included: **Seamus Kelly '21**, **Misha Auskalnis '21**, and **Sam Colon '22**, who had a 50+ goal season. The team finished the season ranked #22 in the state of Illinois by *MaxPreps*.

**GIRLS' LACROSSE** wrapped its toughest season yet with a 9-9 record – advancing to the second round of the playoffs, a best finish for the program. **Maddie Drebing '22**, **Morgan Lyons '21**, and **Carmen Colon '24** were named all-conference and all-sectional players. Other program milestones: Colon scored eight goals in a game; Drebing was named all-state and committed to play lacrosse at a Division 1 school (Duke University); and Holland committed to play at a Division 2 school (Lewis University).

**BOYS' SOCCER** finished with a 9-6 record and came in third in conference. All-conference honors went to **Liam Bennett '22**, **Kevin Brennan '21**, **Marc Anthony Carreon '22**, **Martin O'Connor '21**, and **Jimmy Valek '21**. Valek, who was named conference offensive player of the year set the single season scoring record with 20 goals in a shortened season. He also set the record for goals per game (1.33) in a season. Carreon received an all-sectional honorable mention; Bennett received all-sectional honors; and Valek earned all-state recognition.

**GIRLS' SOCCER** finished fourth in conference with a 10-8 record. All-conference honors went to **Cecilia Light '21**, **Ciara Bridges '21**, and **Paulina Gutierrez '22**. Other honors include: Light (all-state, all-area), Gutierrez and Bridges (all-sectional), and Light and Bridges (all-area).



**BOYS' TENNIS** placed third in the sectional tournament. **Brayden Bartecki '23**, **Billy Oikonomou '21**, and **Ben Marks '21** qualified and competed in the state tournament for tennis. Bartecki placed second in the sectional tournament at singles, Oikonomou and Marks placed fourth in the sectional tournament at doubles and second at the Lake Park Invitational.



▲ **BOYS' TRACK & FIELD** finished 52-1 during the regular season, including winning the Brian Ferguson Invitational, the Thomas Leonard Invitational, St. Ignatius Invitational, St. Rita Classic, Sophomore ESCC Championships, Varsity ESCC Championships, and the first IHSA Sectional Title since 1982. A record 19 athletes qualified for the IHSA State Track and Field championships, including: **Ak'Tavion Agee '22** (4x200m relay), **Emilio Alvarado '23** (4x200m relay alternate), **Carter Auer '21** (high jump), **Michael Coy '22** (4x200m relay), **Brody Doyle '21** (4x800m relay, 400m), **Brendan Geary '22** (4x800m relay), **Jamari Grant '21** (long jump), **Josh Harris '21** (discus, shot put), **Josiah Harris '21** (110m high hurdles, 4x200m relay alternate), **Darryl Jackson-Mitchell '24** (4x200m relay alternate), **Tommy Kavanaugh '21** (4x800m relay alternate), **Andrew Kerlin '22** (4x800m relay), **Kyle Lyke '23** (4x200m relay), **Jacob Martineck '23** (4x200m relay alternate), **Vince Moreno '23** (4x800m relay alternate), **Tyler O'Brochta '22** (4x200m relay), **Danny Olsen '23** (4x800m relay), **Jake Phillips '22** (3200m run, 4x800m relay alternate), and **Kyle Quinn '22** (4x800m relay alternate). At the state championships, Josh Harris earned all-state honors by placing third in the discus, and the RedHawks came within 29 points of the state title.

**GIRLS' TRACK & FIELD** finished second in conference and third at the state sectional. Five girls qualified for state: **Ashlin Palzkill '21** (300 low hurdles), **Ana Coleman '22** (discus), **Brenna Dunlap '24** (pole vault), **Grace Misunus '22** (high jump), and **Moira Sullivan '23** (pole vault).

**GIRLS' VOLLEYBALL** finished second in the ESCC Tournament. All-conference players included: **Ellie Kurpeikis '21**, **Nikki Jones '21**, **Ewelina Gacek '21**, and **Kamryn Chaney '23**.

The **FOOTBALL** team finished 4-2 with the biggest win coming against Brother Rice in an incredibly hard-hitting game at Red & White Stadium in Week 2. One of the highlights of the season was the dominating performance of senior offensive lineman **Patrick Coogan '21** as well as the entire defense against Nazareth in the team's 13-0 victory. The following players were named to the ESCC/CCL All-Conference team at the end of the season: **Patrick Coogan '21**, **Triston Schultz '21**, **Matt Rolek '21**, **Jovan Marsh '21**, **Patrick Winters '21**, **Dontrell Jackson Jr. '22**, and **Jimmy Rolder '22**.

Patrick Coogan was named first-team all-state by the Illinois High School Football Coaches' Association. He also was named to the *Chicago Sun-Times* All-Area Team and first team All-Area by the *Chicago Tribune/Daily Southtown*. ## Softball wins 2021 state title

**MARIST'S SOFTBALL TEAM** won the state title in thrilling fashion on June 18 at Louisville Slugger Sports Complex in Peoria, Ill. The team first faced defending state champion Huntley High School and won 1-0 during pitcher **Abby Dunning's '21** no hitter. Just hours later, at 5 p.m., the RedHawks took on Lincoln-Way Central (LWC) in the title game. Out to an early lead, the RedHawks were up 3-1 as they entered the seventh inning. LWC had one on and one out but their next two hits were fly balls that **Isabel Cunnea '23** and **Kaitlyn Wright '22** caught, respectively, to end the game.

Two games in one day and heat above 90 degrees was a challenge, especially for Dunning who pitched both games, but the RedHawks battled through for the program's third state title (2012, 2015). The team also placed fourth in state in 2017 and 2019.

The RedHawks were undefeated in the state of Illinois and had only one 1-0 loss to Indiana power Lake Central. In the playoffs, the team defeated Oak Park-River Forest and York to win the sectional title and Hinsdale Central and Proviso West to capture the regional title after winning the super-sectional title in a game (10-0) over Taft High School. The head coach is **Colleen Biebel Phelan '07**.

The team was ranked fifth in the nation according to *MaxPreps*. They outscored opponents in playoffs 65-2. 📈

CAPRON '74**

**ACCORDING TO DAN CAPRON '74**, “some of the most golden moments of high school occur during after-school activities.” Not wanting to be a part of the “dreaded 2:39 Club,” Capron stayed well past the final bell to explore his passions and develop his talents. Although he played football his freshman year, he found his niche on the cross-country team where he would flourish under the tutelage of Br. Rich Grenier and Ronald Horbatiuk. He also made his mark as a member of the National Honor Society, student council, and yearbook staff.

Capron went on to become a respected workers’ compensation attorney – eventually co-founding Capron & Avgerinos, a prominent law firm in Chicago. Even during the hustle and bustle of building a law practice and raising four daughters with his wife Mary Anne, Capron managed to stay active at Marist – serving on the school’s board of directors as well as the Marist Brothers’ development board.

While Capron never seriously pursued football as a player, he later excelled on the field as a Big Ten football official, along with fellow Marist Hall of Famer Jim “Red” Ryan ’72. Capron worked two Big Ten championship games and numerous bowl games, including the Orange Bowl, Sugar Bowl and Peach Bowl. However, the highlight of his officiating career was the national championship game in January 2018 between Alabama and Georgia. For any college football official, that is the “top of the mountain.” Capron retired from the Big Ten at the end of the 2019 season with 20 years of fond memories.

Reflecting on entering the Marist Hall of Fame for Lifetime Achievement, Capron ponders how the school has been so formative to him over the years. “Marist has honored me with this award, but the reverse should be true,” he said. “Whatever my achievements in life have been, I owe a great debt to the Marist Brothers, to the lay teachers, and to my classmates, all of whom pushed me, challenged me, and indelibly marked me as fundamentally ‘Marist.’ The school might appear very different now, but the Marist spirit is unchanged. To have been selected for the Marist Hall of Fame, given the thousands of brilliant and talented men and women who have traversed its hallways, is a humbling experience and one that I will cherish.” 📌

**WHEN DAVE CAHILL '95** thinks of Marist High School he thinks of family. “The friendships I made during school and basketball have lasted a lifetime,” Cahill said. “The Marist family has impacted my life in so many positive ways between sports and academics.”

Cahill could feel that strong sense of family his junior year when the team won conference. It was the first time in a long time that the program realized that level of success and, at least for Cahill, that was due in large part to his teammates and coaches. “It was a special group of guys,” Cahill said. “We still talk on a regular basis, and it’s never about the wins, it’s about the time we spent together.”

Their bond was made stronger thanks to the tough love offered by Coach Ken Styler '75 and Coach Brian Tucker. The coaches expected a lot from their players – encouraging them to do more and never settle for anything less than the best.

“The coaches were tough on us,” Cahill said. “But, I think they taught us the value of hard work and the meaning of the old adage that when life knocks you down, you have to get back up.”

Cahill, perhaps more than anyone else on the team, took those lessons to heart – earning all-area and all-conference honors two years in a row. Although an injury kept him off the court his senior year, he bounced back with force playing all four years at the University of St. Francis. In college, Cahill earned accolades from coaches and teammates alike, including all-conference honors and most valuable player two years in a row.

Cahill, a key account manager for Lakeshore Beverage, lives with his wife Erica and their three children in Beverly. Cahill is president of the St. John Fisher Holy Name Society and a basketball and baseball coach for neighborhood teams. Cahill’s volunteer nature is a direct reflection of the people that impacted his childhood: “When I was growing up, there were so many volunteers who coached me, gave of their time, because they loved giving back,” Cahill said. “My coaches have always meant a lot to me and helped me develop into the person I am today.” +

**MARY PAT CONNOLLY** believes Marist High School is a special place because of its commitment to the overall success of the student-athlete – academically and athletically – that paves the way for the continued success of future RedHawks. And, Connolly knows a little something about success.

Having served as the girls’ basketball coach since the school went coed in 2002, Connolly has more than 400 career wins under her belt. Over the last 20 years, her teams have captured regional, sectional, and super-sectional titles as well as a 4<sup>th</sup> place state title in 2008. “We’ve had great seasons and many memorable moments, but the 2008 season stands out the most to me,” Connolly said. “We weren’t the most talented team, but we had a team of hard-working, over-achievers who refused to quit.”

Connolly knows first-hand what it takes to succeed on the court. In 2018, she was inducted into the National Women’s Basketball Hall of Fame for her time with the Chicago Hustle in the Women’s Basketball League (WBL) from 1979 to 1981. The following year, she was inducted into the Illinois Basketball Coaches Association Hall of Fame as a player and, in 2020, she was inducted as a coach.

Before her time in the WBL, Connolly had a decorated career at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. She still remains a record leader in scoring, rebounding, double-doubles, and more.

“It truly is an honor to be inducted into the Marist Hall of Fame,” Connolly said. “Starting from the first class of girls, I was fortunate to have so many former and current coaches and players help me succeed and sustain such a successful program. I feel I’m a small part of a rich tradition of athletic success that has been built at Marist since the school first opened.” +

**IT'S BEEN 35 YEARS, BUT MATT QUINN '88** still holds the IHSA record for an interception returned for a touchdown. A junior at the time, Quinn intercepted a pass 4 yards deep in the end zone and returned it for a touchdown with 30 seconds left in the game. The interception enabled Marist, which had never won a playoff game before, to advance to the semifinals. The team played for the state championship that year.

"The excitement of playing in state playoff games bonds a team together and makes for lifelong friendships," Quinn said. "Those relationships with my teammates, coaches, and teachers have shaped me into the person I am today."

Quinn's prowess on the football field was evident as a two-way starter on the 1986 and 1987 teams as well as all-area and all-conference honoree. But, his accomplishments didn't stop there. He also was a two-year starting catcher for the baseball team, which finished third in state in 1988. An all-around sports enthusiast, Quinn loved watching other Marist teams play as well.

"Supporting other sporting events truly made me feel and experience the full high school life that Marist offered and still offers to its students," Quinn said. "The opportunities are there, you just have to enjoy them."

The Quinn legacy is large at Marist with Matt's three brothers among its alumni and his son Billy a current senior on the football team. Matt, a deputy commissioner for the city of Chicago's Water Department, and his wife Debbie also have a son Ryan and daughter-in-law Mary Kate, a 2010 grad. The couple actively raise money for causes near and dear to them, including the fight against breast cancer, research for muscular dystrophy, and scholarship opportunities through the Born N Razed Foundation.

"My induction into the Marist Hall of Fame is an honor that should be shared by everyone," Quinn said. "All my coaches, all my teammates, all my opponents, and especially my family. Without all of them this would not have been possible."

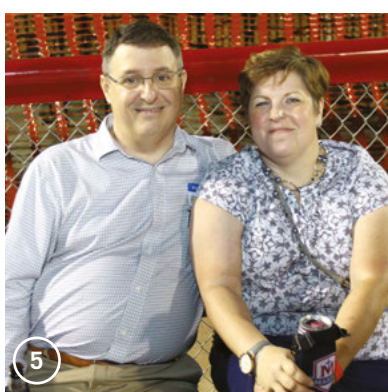

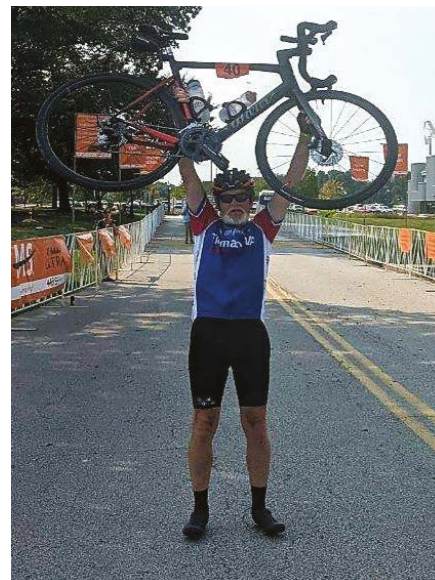

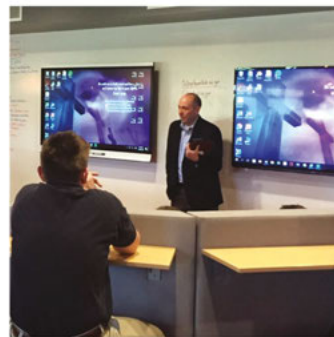
