PREPARE FOR SOUTHSIDE SUMMER FESTIVAL

- No tickets yet? Don't worry General Admission Tickets can be purchased in advance until **Friday**, **July 19 at 11:55pm for \$35.** Tickets will be available at the **Ticket Booth** for \$40 using either cash or credit card or Venmo.
- If you purchased tickets in advance, GoFan.co will send an email/text with your ticket details on **7.20.24 at 2 p.m.** Check our website if you don't receive your tickets for details to contact GoFan.
- IMPORTANT- Tickets cannot be redeemed until Gates open. **DO NOT REDEEM TICKETS UNTIL SOUTHSIDE SUMMER FESTIVAL STAFF DIRECT YOU AT GATE** (Redeeming before a staff member sees it forfeits your ticket(s)).
- If you received your tickets in an email/text from GoFan.co: Move directly to the **Ticket Redemption Line** at the **Gate Check-In** when you arrive.
- Anyone smoking or vaping on the field turf will be asked to leave immediately. Designated smoking area is located in the Northeast corner past the bleachers.
- Things to have ready for check in your **ID and bag/purse**. All bags and personal items will be searched by security before entry. All patrons must be 21 years of age or older. Patrons 30 years old and younger- Please have your ID ready.
- ★ No re-entry will be allowed under any circumstance.
- No chairs allowed on the field. Blankets welcome. Stadium seating will be open.
- No outside food or alcohol can be brought into the event.
- In addition to the **Marist parking lot**, **Worth Township Hall** will be used for overflow parking.
- **Taxi/Rideshare stand** will be located outside the Hynes Gym Entrance at Marist.

*Reminder: During Southside Summer Festival, Marist High School's buildings will be completely closed to all, including faculty and staff!
