ATHLETICS

- Boys' Volleyball: The program is off to a great start after winning multiple tournaments, including the prestigious Karch Kiraly Tournament in California, where they defeated the nation's #1 ranked team, Mira Costa High School.
- Girls' Softball: The team has excelled, posting a 14-1 record to start the season.
- Boys' Baseball: The team has been on a roll, defeating conference rivals Nazareth, Notre Dame, and Benet, as well as local rival Providence Catholic.
- Boys' Track: The program won the Marist Indoor Invitational and has continued its success outdoors, most recently winning the Rice Relays.
- Girls' Track: The team has recorded numerous personal bests to start the year and finished in 1st place at the 10-team Marist Invite on April 11. Marist will host the ESCC Championships on Wednesday, May 7.
- Boys' Tennis: Off to a strong start with a 7-3 record, the team has earned notable conference wins over JCA and Marian Catholic. They also performed well at the Lake Park Invitational, where the second doubles team won 1st place at their position.
- Boys' Lacrosse: The team has posted a 5-3 record with impressive wins over conference rivals Carmel, Notre Dame, St. Patrick, and Benet, and recently added Mt. Carmel to the list of victories.
- Girls' Lacrosse: The team has had recent success with wins over Lincoln Way Central, Latin, Nazareth, and DePaul.
- Girls' Soccer: Recent victories include wins over Marian Catholic, Highland Park, and JCA.
- Boys' Rugby: The team is 4-0 with wins over Taft, Morton, St. Rita, and Mt. Carmel.
- Girls' Rugby: Marist is fielding a girls' rugby team for the first time in school history this spring and it's off to a terrific start.
