

Marist High School Financial Assistance



Home of the RedHawks

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Current tuition is
\$16,000 (2026-2027)

- Registration fee is \$400
- Marist High School does not charge any fees for Fundraising
- Payments are divided into 10 payments starting in July and ending in April
- Marist will work with families to create flexible payment arrangements

Financial Assistance



- Average Award per family is \$3,750.
- 92% of financial assistance applicants receive an award
- Currently over 66% of our students receive financial assistance
- 74 First Responder, class of 2030 applicants, received Marist Financial Assistance.



Class of 2031 Discounts

- A \$300 Early Payment Credit is given for families who pay tuition in full By July 31st
- \$1,000 sibling discount for 2nd student
- \$2,000 sibling discount for 3rd student
- 4th sibling in the building attends for free



Class of 2031 Discounts

- **First Responder Discount**

- \$1000 (renewable)
- Parents who are a Current Fire Fighter, Police Officer, Nurse, Paramedic, Active Military (Only one parent can receive this and must be the applicant or co-applicant on the application)
- The Marist Financial Assistance application must be completed to qualify



Academic Scholarships For Freshmen



- RedHawk Scholarship \$5,000 annually – \$20,000 total
 - Based on local percentile of 95+ on entrance exam

- Champagnat Scholarship \$3,000 annually - \$12,000 total
 - Based on local percentile of 90 to 94 on entrance exam

- Brothers Scholarship \$2,000 annually - \$8,000 total
 - Based on local percentile of 85 to 89 on entrance exam

- All renew automatically with “B” average

Marist Endowed Scholarships

- There are 52 named scholarships with various criteria.
- The Marist Financial Assistance application must be submitted for consideration for these scholarships.
- Endowment scholarships are awarded to incoming freshmen and will renew providing that students meet the scholarship criteria and other eligibility requirements.



Work Study



- Marist has over 200 students participating in our work study program
 - Lunch Work Study
 - 5 to 10 minutes commitment per day
 - Before or After School Work Study
 - 30 to 50 minutes a few days per week
 - Flexible with athletes/club schedules
 - Stadium Clean-Ups after football games/events
 - Can have multiple family members volunteer to all earn for tuition credit
- Credit earned each month is applied directly towards the student's tuition

- Families pay \$30 to FACTS as an application fee

Important Details

- **MOST IMPORTANT!** – Please submit the application for Financial Assistance on time!
 - Include the first 2 pages of your 2025 1040 tax return form if 2026 is not yet complete
 - Include your 2026 W-2 forms
- Families with siblings currently attending Marist only need to submit one application

Important Dates for incoming freshmen (Class of 2031)

- **October 25, 2026**– FACTS accepts financial assistance applications for 2027-2028 school year
- **November 13, 2026** – Registration for Entrance Exam Opens
- **December 5, 2026** – Entrance exam
- **December 14, 2026** -- Application for Admission Due
- **February 1, 2027** – Admission decision, student letter notification.
- **February 5, 2027** - Financial Assistance deadline for all families with an incoming Freshmen



Important Dates for Incoming Freshmen (Continued)

- **March 2, 2027** – Parent information night at 6pm in the Main Gym
- **March 5, 2027** – Incoming Freshmen notified of financial assistance awards. An email will be sent to families by Marist through FACTS
- **March 10, 2027** - Registration fee is due and course form due
- **June 15, 2027** – Ipad Payment Due



Important Dates for Returning Students

- Must I reapply each year?
 - Yes, all families must reapply and generally will receive the same amount of assistance as the previous year
- April 16, 2027 –Financial Assistance applications deadline for returning students. Late applications could result in a decrease in award amount
- May 28, 2027 – Current/Returning Students notified of Financial Assistance Award. An email will be sent to families by Marist through FACTS
